

Thursday Open Three Card Poker Tournament **Rules and Regulations**

1. The active dates for this tournament will be every Thursday in 2010 (excluding November 25, 2010 & December 30, 2010).
2. There will be a \$25.00 entry fee for this tournament.
3. Limited to a total of 126 players.
4. Players will use non-negotiable tournament chips for the tournament.
5. The tournament will consist of five (5) rounds.
6. No more than seven (7) players will be allowed on each table.
7. Each entrant will start with \$500 in tournament chips for each round. Chips will not carry over once a round is finished.
8. Betting limits are \$5.00 - \$500.00. All bets will be in \$5.00 increments.
9. Each round will consist of fifteen (15) hands.

1 st round starts at	7:00 PM
2 nd round starts at	7:45 PM
3 rd round starts at	8:30 PM
Semi-final round starts at	9:15 PM
Final round starts at	10:00 PM

10. Tournament entrants that are late for a round will be penalized \$50 in Tournament chips for every hand missed.
11. Seating positions and times of play will be drawn for prior to the start of the tournament.
12. First base will be determined by a draw of the cards. Low card will be first base on the initial hand. On the successive hands, the marker will move clockwise from that player.
13. Players are allowed no more than thirty (30) seconds to place a bet when it is his or her turn.
14. Chips must be in clear view at all times and must be stacked separately by denomination.
15. No string betting. Bets must be slid into the circle, highest denomination chip on the bottom to the lowest denomination chip on top. If a player string bets, the first chip to hit the felt inside the betting circle will be the player's bet.
16. Once a bet has been made, it cannot be changed.
17. If necessary, ties will be broken by a playoff of three (3) hands. First base will be predetermined and each player will start with \$500 in tournament chips.
18. Any dispute or error will be adjusted or corrected by the tournament coordinator. Table and Seat placement can be changed by the tournament coordinator to even up the tables as well as advancement depending on headcount and tournament requirements.
19. All misdeals will result in a dead hand.
20. Sam's Town reserves the right to accept or deny any entry into the tournament.
21. All entrants must be at least twenty-one (21) years of age and a B Connected member in good standing with the casino to participate.

22. Regular Sam's Town Casino Three-Card Poker rules will apply. Players not adhering to these rules may be disqualified at the discretion of the casino management. Disqualified players will not share in any prizes or awards. Tournament participants agree to accept as binding all decisions made by Sam's Town Casino as to all tournament rules, regulations, and/or play.
23. The top 2 players from each table in the first three rounds will advance to the semi-final round with the top player from each table in the semi-final round advancing to the final round.
24. After the semi-final round is over, one wildcard name will be drawn from the non-winners for the 7th and final spot in the final round.
25. Prize money for each Wagering Pool (entry fees) Tournament will be broken down as follows:

1st Place	40%
2nd Place	20%
3rd Place	11 %
4th Place	9%
5th Place	8%
6th Place	7%
7th Place	5%

26. Employees of Sam's Town Casino and their immediate families of Casino and Casino Marketing Departments are not eligible to participate in this promotion. Immediate family is defined as father, mother, husband, wife son, daughter, brother, sister, grandfather, grandmother, grandchild, mother-in-law, father-in-law, son-in-law, daughter-in-law, sister-in-law, brother-in-law, and any step relative.
27. Any vendor or immediate family member of a vendor who provides promotional items for a promotion, tournament, or drawing shall be prohibited from participating in that activity.
28. Boyd may disqualify any person for any prize based upon fraud, dishonesty, violation of tournament rules or other misconduct whether or not related to this tournament.
29. The Mississippi Gaming Commission reserves the right to investigate any and all complaints and disputes regarding tournaments, promotions, and drawings. Such disputes and complaints will be resolved in accordance with the Mississippi Gaming Act and the Mississippi Gaming Commission Regulations.
30. Management reserves the right to cancel, change or modify the tournament, promotion or drawing with prior notification to the Mississippi Gaming Commission, but must do so at least three (3) days prior to the commencement of the activity.
